AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM

The PTO administers 3 sessions of a "After School Program" at the middle school. Due in part to the make-up days needed for the Winter ASP session, the Spring ASP session will run for six (6) weeks beginning **the week of April 27th and running through the week of June 1st. Each class costs \$45 per student.** Classes will meet once a week and begin after school dismissal at 2:30pm and run for 1 hour until 3:30pm. There are no morning classes offered this session and there will be no classes held on holidays, school snow days or early release school days. Missed classes will be made up the week of June 8th and subsequent weeks if necessary.

Each class requires a minimum of 6 registered students to run. Classes will be filled as registrations are received on a first come, first served basis. Each class also has a maximum number of students that is set by the instructor. Your student may sign up for more than one class. All material fees are included in the \$45 registration.

To register your student, please fill out the attached form and **return it to the middle school office no later than 3:00 pm on Friday, April 17th.** You will be notified by email before the first class on the status of your registration. Late registrations may be accepted, space permitting. Registration fees will not be adjusted for classes missed.
