The PTO administers 3 sessions of an After School Program at the Swampscott Middle School that is open to grades 5th – 8th, unless specified. **The Fall 2018 session will begin the week of September 24th and will run through November 30th.*** Each class has its cost listed in the description on the flyer and in the “Class Registration” portion of the online form. (*Please note: Dodgeball will end on November 14th.)

Classes will meet once a week after school dismissal at 2:30 pm and will run for 1 hour until 3:30 pm.* No classes will be held on holidays, school snow days, or early release school days. Classes missed for these reasons or teacher absence will be made up the weeks of December 3rd and/or 10th. For example, there will be no classes on Columbus Day, so make-up classes will be held on Monday, December 3rd for those missed classes. (*Please note: both D&D classes will run for 2 hours from 2:30-4:30 pm.)

Each class requires a minimum of 6 registered students in order to run. Classes will be filled as registrations are received on a first come first served basis. Each class also has a maximum number of students that is set by the instructor. Your student may sign up for more than one class.
